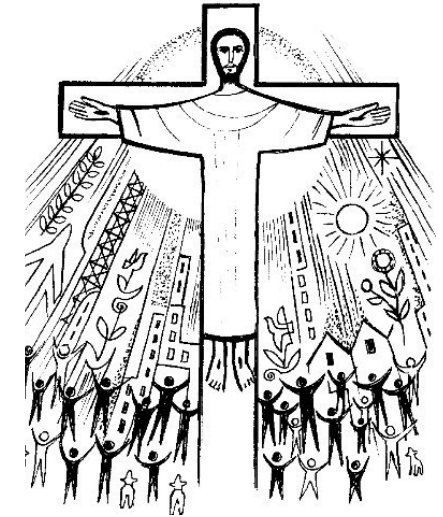
St John's is the Church of England (Anglican) parish church of the Hackney bit of Finsbury Park.
